Changes at Grenfell Pioneer Home – August 23, 2018

The Saskatchewan Health Authority's (SHA) greatest priority and commitment is ensuring the safety of its patients, residents and staff across the province.

As part of ongoing maintenance and monitoring of Grenfell Pioneer Home, SHA commissioned an investigation into mould growth found in the facility. The report confirmed that there is mould growth in numerous locations throughout the building, including resident rooms.

One of our goals as a provincial health authority is to create a health system culture that promotes patient and staff safety. With that in mind, SHA has made the decision to take precautionary measures and relocate all residents of Grenfell Pioneer Home to other facilities.

We have acted to ensure that our residents continue to receive safe, quality care. Communication with residents, their families, and staff at Grenfell Pioneer Home has already started and will be ongoing.

The SHA and Ministry of Health are developing options regarding the future of long-term care services in Grenfell. This could include continued maintenance at Grenfell Pioneer Home or construction of a new facility.

We will continue to provide updates to the community of Grenfell and surrounding area as we know more information.
