



UPDATE REGARDING NURSING HOME CLOSURE

Since our last update

- We have had numerous conversations with MLA Steven Bonk who again assured us that he is keeping the file top of mind. He has been in communication with the Ministers responsible on a regular basis
- We spoke with Minister Responsible for Rural & Remote Health, Hon. Greg Ottenbreit who reiterated that long-term care in Grenfell remains a priority to the Government and they continue to work towards a solution.
 - Minister Ottenbreit talked about our nursing home in a speech he delivered on November 28th where he again stated that long-term care would be restored to Grenfell
- An update from the Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA) today states that internal discussions continue after analyzing the Request for Expression of Interest (REOI)

We understand this remains a sensitive issue with the people of Grenfell and surrounding areas – and we assure everyone that this also remains a top priority for the Town of Grenfell. We have and will continue to offer any help we can give to the SHA and the Ministry of Health to restore long-term care to Grenfell in a timely manner. We continue to commit to an open and respectful dialogue with those tasked with finding our much-needed solution.
